- Electric storage water heaters must have a minimum 40-gallon storage tank.
- Electric and heat pump water heaters must be listed in the GAMA directory.
- The water heater must be used for domestic water heating only and cannot be used in conjunction with radiant space heating systems.
- The electric water heater must be energized (not used as a storage only tank).
- Electric water heaters or heat pump unit cannot be connected to a gas system in any way.

## Terms and Conditions—Water Heater Program

**Program Offer:** The Program covers products purchased and/or services rendered on or after **July 1, 2008**.

**Program Eligibility Criteria:**

1. Water heaters must be electric and must have an Energy Factor as shown in the table below.
2. Heat pump water heaters are eligible for a rebate and are also listed in the GAMA directory. Both add-on heat pump water heaters and units integrated with a storage tank may qualify.
3. The water heater must be used for domestic water heating only. The unit cannot be used in conjunction with radiant space heating systems (e.g. boiler for in-floor or baseboard heating).
4. Electric storage water heaters must have a minimum 40-gallon storage tank.
5. The electric water heater cannot be connected in any way to a gas system (e.g. cannot use as a storage tank for a gas heated in-floor system).
6. The electric water heater must be energized and cannot be used as a storage only tank. If more than one unit is installed in a building, all units must be energized.
7. Participating members must sign a load control agreement allowing future control of these water heaters on a limited basis (maximum of 2 hours per day).

**Limitation of Liability:**

Participating Customers agree that the Cooperative's liability, in connection with this Program, is limited to paying the Program Incentive specified (when all Terms and Conditions have been satisfied by the customer). Under no circumstances shall the Cooperative be liable for any consequential or incidental damages resulting from participation in this Program.

**Participating Customer's Certification:**

Participating Customer certifies that he/she purchased and installed the equipment listed in their application at their defined location served by the Cooperative. Participating Customer agrees that all information is true and that he/she has conformed to all of the program and equipment requirements listed in the application.

**Program Changes/Termination:**

While this rebate program will be in effect for an indefinite period, the Cooperative reserves the right to extend, modify (this includes incentive levels) or terminate this Program without prior or further notice. Typically a 60 day notice of cancellation will be made in the event that any program is terminated. The customer is responsible for checking with the Cooperative to determine whether the program has been changed or is still in effect.

**Other Conditions**

The cooperative reserves the right to inspect installations before issuing the rebate. If the application does not comply with the cooperative's rules and qualifications, the rebate amount may be adjusted.

Customers must apply for rebates within one year of the purchase date (as shown on the customer's invoice). Past eligibility, however, does not guarantee that equipment will meet criteria for current programs in effect.
