For split systems (most common), both a new evaporator coil (inside the indoor unit) and outdoor condenser unit must be installed to be eligible.

Terms and Conditions—Energy Star Central Air Conditioner Program

Program Offer: The Program covers products purchased and/or services rendered on or after **April 1, 2006**.

Equipment and Installation Eligibility Requirements:

1. All residential central air conditioners must be Energy Star® labeled and meet current “Energy-Efficiency Criteria for Energy Star Qualified Residential Central Air Conditioners”. Current Energy Star Information, specifications and qualifying equipment list can be found at: http://www.energystar.gov/index.cfm?c=cac.pr_central_ac.
2. Members must provide a copy of the receipt to verify equipment installation. Invoices should contain size, efficiency and model and serial numbers for all equipment.
3. Participating Members agree to allow future cycling/control of their central air conditioner (Using 15 to 20 minute on/off cycling, a maximum daily interruption of 3 hours would be allowed). Note: A control program is not currently in effect, but the Cooperative may activate such a program in the future to ensure power reliability and stable rates.

Split Systems (most common)

Most residential air conditioning systems consist of indoor and outdoor equipment with a SEER (Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio) that has been determined for each matching assembly. To be eligible, members must install both a new outdoor unit (condenser) and a new matching indoor A-coil (evaporator).

The SEER for a matched split system must be verified and meet the minimum efficiency required for the appropriate incentive (see table below) regardless of whether the system is listed or labeled as Energy Star. An Energy Star label on the outdoor unit does not ensure that the installed system, which also includes the indoor evaporator coil and blower assembly, meets Energy Star requirements for central air conditioning equipment.

The installing contractor should provide the homeowner with the SEER rating for their specific system. SEER ratings for matched equipment should also be listed in the online ARI (Air-Conditioning and Refrigeration Institute) Unitary Directory at: www.aridirectory.org/ari/ac.php

Single Packaged Units

These units are less common in residential applications. They are single package units (compressor/blower combination unit) often installed on a slab or roof or through the wall. If a heating option is available, the unit must utilize electricity as the source of heating.

Application and Eligibility Process:

The Participating Member must ultimately own the equipment, either through an up-front purchase or at the end of a short-term lease. Equipment procured by members through another program offered by the Cooperative may not be eligible for a rebate through this Program.

Warranty Information:

The Cooperative makes no warranties, expressed or implied, with respect to equipment operation, material, workmanship or manufacturing. The Cooperative does not guarantee that a certain level of energy or cost savings will result from the use of products covered by this program.

Limitation of Liability:

Participating Members agree that the Cooperative’s liability, in connection with this Program, is limited to paying the Program Incentive specified (when all Terms and Conditions have been satisfied by the member). Under no circumstances shall the Cooperative be liable for any consequential or incidental damages resulting from participation in this Program. The Cooperative will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the member as a result of the payment of Program Incentives.

Participating Member’s Certification:

Participating Member certifies that he/she purchased and installed the equipment listed in their application at their defined location served by the Cooperative. Participating Member agrees that all information is true and that he/she has conformed to all of the program and equipment requirements listed in the application.

Program Changes/Termination:

While this rebate program will be in effect for an indefinite period, the Cooperative reserve the right to extend, modify (this includes incentive levels) or terminate this Program without prior or further notice.

Other Program Rules

The cooperative reserves the right to inspect installations before issuing the rebate. If the application does not comply with the cooperative’s rules and qualifications, the rebate amount may be adjusted.

Members must apply for rebates within one year of the purchase date (as shown on the member’s invoice).
